AWARD

Any award granted for *Graduating High School Seniors Who Will Attend a Four-Year College* will be to cover tuition, room, board, books and fees, not to exceed \$10,000. The award will be made directly to the recipient. One-half will be paid upon presentation of evidence of successful completion of the first semester of school and one-half upon presentation of successful completion of the second semester of school. Runner-up finalists will receive \$500. ***Awards are limited to citizens of Maine.***

Each of the four letters of recommendation **must identify the category** of recommendation, the address, phone number, and the title and/or relationship of the person writing the letter for the applicant. Letters of recommendation **must** come from sources other than the applicant's family.

Further information may be requested from the applicant by the Clyde Russell Trust Fund.

A personal interview will be required on Saturday, April 13, 2019 of all finalists.

The interview will include both oral and written responses.

All requested information must be provided. The Clyde Russell Trust Fund assumes no responsibility for incomplete or late applications. **Incomplete applications will not be considered for selection.**
